

Community Foundation Announces Building Stronger Neighborhoods Awards

GREENSBORO, NC – Five Resident Councils will be receiving over \$4,000 for activities to be held in Greensboro Housing Authority (GHA) communities. Kevin S. Lundy, Program Officer for Community Development of the Community Foundation of Greater Greensboro, Inc., announced the award decisions made by the Building Stronger Neighborhoods Committee via email on July 25th. The Building Stronger Neighborhoods program, through neighborhood development and grantmaking, supports Greensboro neighborhoods as they mobilize assets to enhance community quality of life. Nearly all GHA communities that applied received funding.

Grants were awarded to:

- Gateway Plaza Resident Council - \$500 for National Night Out.
- Hickory Trails Resident Council - \$500 for National Night Out and an additional \$1,000 for additional projects.
- Ray Warren Homes Resident Council - \$1,600 for resident activities and events.
- Stoneridge Senior Community Resident Council - \$500 for National Night Out.
