



Jaymar G. Joseph joins Greensboro Housing Authority

Jaymar Joseph has recently joined the Greensboro Housing Authority (“GHA”) as the vice president of Real Estate Development. He provides financing and development oversight over the GHA’s portfolio and will be responsible for the RAD conversion of several GHA properties.

Prior to working with the Greensboro Housing Authority, Mr. Joseph served as the executive director of the Falls Church Housing Corporation and a senior manager at the NHP Foundation located in Washington DC. Mr. Joseph served as a senior development manager to a non-profit foundation, the National Foundation for Affordable Housing

Solutions, Inc. and served as a financial underwriter for the District of Columbia Housing Finance Agency (“DCHFA”). Mr. Joseph financed affordable housing projects, which consisted of tax-exempt bond and low income housing tax credit transactions totaling \$91.4 million.

Mr. Joseph received a Master’s degree in City and Regional Planning from the Georgia Institute of Technology University and an undergraduate degree from the University of Michigan.
