

Lions Provide Free Hearing and Vision Tests for Community

The 60-foot customized trailer was hard to miss in the Greensboro Housing Authority's Hampton Homes' parking lot as the Lions Club offered free vision and hearing screenings to residents on August 20. The Vision Van is a statewide project of North Carolina Lions, Inc. that makes stops throughout the state to carry out its mission to prevent blindness and assist in preserving vision, as well as providing assistance and support to visually and hearing impaired residents.

Trained Lion club members were on hand to help administer both vision and hearing tests and refer those who showed signs of diminished eyesight or hearing loss to professional eye care and hearing specialist. The screenings were no more than 20 minutes and are an important part in the early detection of serious vision and hearing problems.
