

Mary Moore Honored for Ten Years of Service

Greensboro Housing Authority (GHA) Board of Commissioner Mary Moore was honored for her service and commitment to the authority at the December 2012 board meeting. Ms. Moore was appointed to the board of commissioners by the city of Greensboro in June 2001 and has contributed ten years of dedicated service as a member of the board of commissioners, retiring from the board in July 2011.



A resolution recognizing Ms. Moore was introduced and unanimously approved by the entire GHA Board of Commissioners.
