Haworth House and a Partnership in Caring

The Servant Center and the Greensboro Housing Authority have partnered to better serve the needs of the homeless Veteran population. The Servant Center is constructing and will operate nine one-bedroom, permanent supportive apartments for low-income individuals with disabilities. The site will be located in the Glenwood neighborhood of Greensboro, a targeted area for revitalization by the City of Greensboro. As a partner, the Greensboro Housing

Authority will provide eight project-based VASH Vouchers that will allow The Servant Center to use eight of the nine units, specifically, for homeless Veterans. These vouchers will provide that no resident pay more than 30% of his/her income in rent by subsidizing the remainder. As the vouchers will be project-based, residents will not have to wait for a Section 8 Voucher and will be able to move directly into the units. The Servant Center is pleased with the opportunity to work with the Greensboro Housing Authority in



serving the needs of the community.
